

POB DISTRICT CLIMATE RESULTS

At the Board meeting of October 3, 2011, the Superintendent reviewed the district's School Climate Survey results. We have posted the report for your review.

During the spring of 2011, each school had its staff, students and parents complete a School Climate Survey. In August each building principal received an extensive report on the building results and a presentation report which will be shared at PTA meetings in all buildings. The district report summarized the results for all eight schools.

The results point out many strengths particularly in the areas of rules and norms and respect for diversity. One of the items that resulted in a call to action is a neutral response to the area of social and emotional safety. Each building will use the results to make plans for improvement particularly in this area.

For the district, the Dignity for All Students Committee will use these results to create its plan for anti-bullying and anti-harassment training and instruction. The Board has scheduled a workshop meeting regarding this topic on December 5, 2011.
