Checking out EBooks through the library website

1. Go to the Stratford Library website (<http://www.pobschools.org/domain/302>)
 2. Click on OPAC- Library Catalog Online
 3. Login using your Stratford Road computer user name and password
 4. Click of Follett Shelf to view the eBooks.
 5. Click on the cover of the book to open it and read
 6. Click on the book bag icon to check the book out

Checking out Books through the Follett BryteWave K-12 App

1. Download and open the BryteWave App
2. Login using your school username and password
3. Below the user name and password will be the web address for Stratford's e-books. Type the following into the blank area: wbb07663.follettshef.com (*Note: There are two L's and two T's in Follett.
4. Click on the book icon in the top right corner to see the books available
5. Click on the cover of the book to open it and read
6. Click on the green button to check the book out
