For parents refusing the New York State ELA or Math Exam:

- 1. A letter must be written to the building principal stating which exam(s) your child will be refusing.
- 2. Included within the letter, must be a hand-signed signature.
- 3. Your letter should be sent your child's school to the attention of the principal.
- 4. We would appreciate receiving the information, no later than Tuesday, March 21st for the ELA exam and Tuesday, April 25th for the Math exam, so that the building principal can plan accordingly.

Students refusing the exam will be supervised in a separate location. Students refusing the exam will be instructed to bring multiple independent reading books (no word puzzles or games) and a snack. Keep in mind, no formal instruction will take place during the testing periods which could last approximately 90 minutes or so. Be reminded, New York State exams for the 2016-2017 school year are outlined; therefore, instruction cannot begin until all students have completed testing.
