

Superintendent's Highlight of the Week

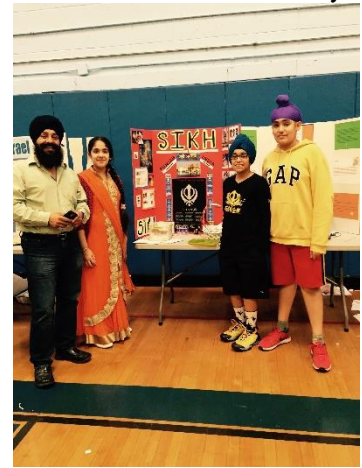
