# Looking Ahead... Acceleration Options in 8th grade

- > Algebra 1
  - -Replaces Math 8
  - -Can only be taken if student takes Math 7ACC in 7th grade
- Earth Science + Lab
  - -Replaces Science 8 and includes a lab every other day
- > Studio Art
  - -Every day for the full year; can indicate interest next year






### **POB JFK HS Mathematics Flow Chart**
