

Summer 2022: POB ~ Driver's Ed Information and FAQs

IN ORDER TO SIGN-UP FOR DRIVER'S EDUCATION:

1. You **MUST** be a student in the Plainview-Old Bethpage District.
2. You **MUST** be at least 16 years old and have your Driver's Permit by June 2022.
3. You **MUST** return your completed contract, check, and copy of permit to the High School.
4. You **MUST** fill out the Google Registration Form. <https://forms.gle/M6o5a1BRv5JXXoQ96>
5. Return registration materials ASAP to secure your spot. **REGISTRATION DEADLINE: 4/14/22**

Lecture classes take place IN-PERSON and will meet for 16 days, MONDAY-FRIDAY. We will run 2 sections: 10:00am-11:30am and 11:30am-1:00pm. The planned dates for the 2022 summer session are June 27,28,29,30, July 1,5,6,7,8,11,12,13,14,15,18,19. Make-up classes [if needed] will be held on July 20.

***Please note that at this time, in-vehicle instruction will be fulfilled by the Parent/Guardian according to COVID related guidance issued by the state. As long as NYS continues to allow parents to fulfill the in-vehicle instruction requirement, the cost will remain \$250

(If there are any changes to the existing New York State directives, we will notify all registrants and make the appropriate changes. (If NY State mandates in-vehicle instruction to resume, we anticipate the cost of the program would rise accordingly and could be as much as \$500-\$600.) If any changes to the program or cost due to changes in New York State directives are necessary, this will be communicated to all who are enrolled before the start of the course in June.)

It is important that both the contract and Google form are filled out completely and accurately. [You will indicate your preference and availability for the offered sections on the Google Form]

FAQs

Q: Do I have to have my permit to register?

A: No, but you must submit a paper copy of your permit **BEFORE** classes start in June or you will not be allowed to participate in the course.

Q: If I fill out the Google Form am I registered for the course?

A: No. To be registered for the course, you must submit the contract and check to the High School AND fill out the Google Form (and submit a copy of the Driver's Permit to the High School before classes start.)

Q: What if I must miss a class due to an Emergency?

A: A student may come to the same lecture at a different time on the same day on a one-time basis. There are also 2 make-up classes scheduled as part of the course at the end of the session.

Q: What are the limitations of a Permit and a Junior License on Long Island?

A: **PERMIT:** A student who has only a Permit on Long Island may drive a vehicle only when accompanied by a licensed parent or professional driving instructor between 5:00 AM and 9:00 PM
