BILL MOVED TO PLAINVIEW IN 1969 AS HE WAS ENTERING 2ND GRADE. HE WAS A THREE SPORT ATHLETE AT JOHN F. KENNEDY HS, EARNING VARSITY LETTERS IN FOOTBALL, WRESTLING AND LACROSSE. HE ALSO PARTICIPATED IN INTRAMURAL BASKETBALL.

DURING HIS HIGH SCHOOL CAREER BILL WAS THE TEAM CAPTAIN ON THE FOOTBALL AND LACROSSE TEAMS. DURING HIS LACROSSE CAREER BILL HELPED KENNEDY HIGH SCHOOL TO BACK TO BACK NORTH SHORE III CHAMPIONSHIPS (1970 AND 1971) AND EARNED ALL-COUNTY HONORS HIS SENIOR YEAR. IN FOOTBALL BILL EARNED ALL-DIVISION HONORS DURING HIS SENIOR YEAR AND LED KENNEDY HS TO AN UNDEFEATED LEAGUE RECORD AND THE ONLY FOOTBALL CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP IN KENNEDY HIGH SCHOOL HISTORY. IN WRESTLING HE FINISHED 6TH IN THE COUNTY DURING HIS JUNIOR SEASON.

AFTER GRADUATION BILL WENT TO THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS AND PLAYED LACROSSE FOR 4 YEARS. HE WAS A 4 YEAR STARTER ON DEFENSE FOR THE MINUTEMEN AND WAS NAMED TO THE ALL-NEW ENGLAND TEAM FOUR TIMES. DURING HIS SENIOR YEAR HE WAS A TEAM CAPTAIN AND NAMED TO THE ALL-AMERICAN TEAM. AS A FRESHMAN IN 1972 BILL HELPED THE MINUTEMEN TO THEIR FIRST EVER POSTSEASON APPEARANCE IN LACROSSE REACHING THE USILA SEMIFINALS. THEY REPEATED THAT FEAT IN 1973 AS WELL.

HE GRADUATED FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS WITH A BACHELOR OF SCIENCE DEGREE IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION. HE THEN GOT HIS MASTER'S DEGREE IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION WITH A CONCENTRATION IN INFORMATION SYSTEMS. HE WAS A MEMBER OF BETA GAMMA SIGMA WHICH WAS AWARDED FOR SCHOLASTIC ACHIEVEMENT.

FOR THE PAST 25 YEARS BILL HAS BEEN A VOLUNTEER BOYS' LACROSSE COACH AT LANGLEY HS IN VIRGINIA AND IN 2011 HE WON THE STATE CHAMPIONSHIP.

BILL IS CURRENTLY A SOFTWARE ENGINEER FOR CGI. HE HAS BEEN MARRIED FOR THE PAST 44 YEAR TO HIS WIFE CHRISTINE, THEY HAVE TWO CHILDREN, REBECCA AND SETH AND TWO GRANDCHILDREN, MAYA AND LIAM.

BASEBALL, FOOTBALL COACH AND CONTRIBUTOR

MARK'S FAMILY MOVED TO OLD BETHPAGE IN 1956. HE WAS A TWO SPORT ATHLETE AT JOHN F. KENNEDY HIGH SCHOOL, WHERE HE PLAYED UNDER HALL OF FAME COACHES, RALPH DRYER (SOCCER) AND DANIEL MARTINSEN (BASEBALL). HE WAS ALSO INSPIRED BY HIS WEIGHTLIFTING COACH LUTHAN DIXON AND MATLIN PE TEACHER MR. CHILLITO.

AFTER GRADUATION MARK WENT TO ADELPHI COLLEGE WHERE HE RECEIVED HIS BA IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND MA IN HEALTH EDUCATION. IN 1971 HE WAS NAMED THE "OUTSTANDING MEMBER OF THE GRADUATING CLASS" BY THE NASSAU COMMUNITY PE FACULTY.

PRIOR TO TEACHING IN THE POBCSD MARK TAUGHT IN SMITHTOWN AND PATCHOQUE. IN 1985 MARK BEGAN HIS TEACHING CAREER IN THE PLAINVIEW-OLD BETHPAGE CSD WERE HE TAUGHT PHYSICAL EDUCATION AT POBMS AND POB-JFK HS. DURING HIS TIME AT POB HE SECURED TWO NYS GRANTS, THE FIRST FOR HIS SUPER HEART ACTION RESISTANCE PROGRAM (SHARP) WHICH HE BROUGHT TO POBMS IN 1985 AND ANOTHER GRANT WHICH ENABLED STUDENTS TO PARTICIPATE IN TESTING AT ADELPHI UNIVERSITY'S EXERCISE PHYSIOLOGY LAB.

MARK COACHED OVER 117 SEASONS AT POB. MARK WAS THE VARSITY FOOTBALL COACH FOR 7 SEASONS (1993-1995 AND 1997-2000).

IN 1986 MARK WAS ALSO INSTRUMENTAL IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE STRENGTH AND CONDITIONING PROGRAM AT POB-JFK HS. HE WAS A CERTIFIED NCSA STRENGTH AND CONDITIONING SPECIALIST. UNDER HIS DIRECTION THE PLAINVIEW-OLD BETHPAGE STRENGTH AND CONDITIONING PROGRAM BECAME NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED WITH DOZENS OF STUDENT ATHLETES GAINING RECOGNITION AS BFS ALL-AMERICAN HONORS AND USA WEIGHTLIFTING RANKINGS. MARK ORGANIZED TWO CHARITY LIFT-A-THONS THAT RAISED \$45,000 AND IN 1992 REEBOK NAMED HIM AMONG THE TOP 50 FITNESS PROFESSIONALS IN THE USA.

IN 1994 MARK WAS NAMED THE VARSITY HEAD BASEBALL COACH AT POB-JFK HS. DURING HIS CAREER HE WON OVER 230 GAMES AND MADE 13 PLAYOFF APPEARANCES. HE WON TWO CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIPS (1999 AND 2004). IN 2003 HE LED THE HAWKS TO A 17-4 RECORD AND THE PROGRAM'S FIRST EVER NASSAU COUNTY CHAMPIONSHIP DEFEATING FARMING-DALE. THE HAWKS THEN WENT ON TO DEFEAT EAST ISLIP IN THE LONG ISLAND CHAMPIONSHIP GAME AND GREECE-ARCADIA IN THE SEMIFINALS. THE TEAM WOULD FINISH THE YEAR AS NYS RUNNERS-UP. MARK WAS AWARDED SECTION 8 COACH OF THE YEAR IN 2003 AND CONFERENCE COACH OF THE YEAR IN 2004. HE WAS ALSO AWARDED THE SPORTSMANSHIP AWARD IN 2007.

MARK WAS ALSO INSTRUMENTAL IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE GIRLS' LACROSSE PROGRAM AT POB.

Mark retired from teaching in 2009 and moved to Virginia with his wife of 48 years, Barbara.



# JON FEINSTEIN

JOHN F. KENNEDY HIGH SCHOOL CLASS OF 1976 LACROSSE, BASKETBALL AND FOOTBALL

JON WAS BORN IN LEVITTOWN, NY, BUT HE MOVED TO PLAINVIEW IN 1964. HE WAS A THREE SPORT ATHLETE AT JOHN F. KENNEDY HIGH SCHOOL, EARNING 3 VARSITY LETTERS IN EACH OF THE FOLLOWING SPORTS - LACROSSE, FOOTBALL AND BASKETBALL.

DURING HIS TIME AT KENNEDY HIGH SCHOOL JON WAS NAMED CAPTAIN OF THE FOOTBALL AND LACROSSE TEAMS, HIS JUNIOR AND SENIOR SEASONS. HE EARNED ALL-COUNTY HONORS AS A SENIOR IN FOOTBALL. IN LACROSSE JON HELPED KENNEDY HIGH SCHOOL TO THREE PLAYOFF APPEARANCES. DURING HIS SENIOR YEAR HE EARNED ALL-COUNTY HONORS. DURING HIS BASKETBALL CAREER HE HELPED THE TEAM TO 53 WINS AND 2 PLAYOFF APPEARANCES.

AFTER GRADUATION JON WENT TO HOBART COLLEGE AND STARRED ON THE LACROSSE TEAM. ONCE AGAIN JON WAS NAMED CAPTAIN OF THE LACROSSE TEAM DURING HIS JUNIOR AND SENIOR YEARS. HE WAS PART OF TWO NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP TEAMS, 1977 AND 1980, WHILE A MEMBER OF THE STATESMEN LACROSSE TEAM. DURING HIS SENIOR SEASON IN 1980 HE LED HOBART TO THE DIVISION III NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP WHERE THEY DEFEATED CORTLAND 10-8. HE WAS NAMED 3RD TEAM ALL-AMERICAN (1980).

HE GRADUATED FROM HOBART COLLEGE WITH A BACHELOR OF SCIENCE DEGREE IN HISTORY. IN 1981, JON WAS AN ASSISTANT COACH ON THE HOBART LACROSSE TEAM AND HELPED THE TEAM EARN ANOTHER NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP.

SHORTLY AFTER GRADUATION JON WAS DIAGNOSED WITH STAGE 4 NON-HODGKIN'S LYMPHOMA. AFTER GOING INTO REMISSION JON MOVED TO SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA AND STUDIED TO BECOME A HISTORY TEACHER. UNFORTUNATELY, JON LOST HIS LIFE AT THE AGE OF JUST 27.

JON'S LEGACY STILL LIVES ON TODAY WITH THE JON FEINSTEIN MEMORIAL FUND. IN 36 YEARS, THE JON FEINSTEIN MEMORIAL FUND HAS FINANCED A NUMBER OF WORTHY PROJECTS, ALL, AS PER JON'S WISHES, TO HELP KIDS — AWARDING COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS, FUNDING LACROSSE PROGRAMS, SENDING INNER-CITY KIDS TO THE HOBART LACROSSE CAMP AND STARTING THE FIRST HARLEM MIDDLE SCHOOL LACROSSE TEAM.



# **ADAM FUCHS**

POB-JFK HS CLASS OF 1999 GOLF

ADAM WAS BORN IN MANHASSET, NY BUT MOVED TO PLAINVIEW WHEN HE WAS IN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL. HE PARTICIPATED ON THE VARSITY GOLF TEAM AT POB-JFK HS, EARNING 4 VARSITY LETTERS.

During his time on the golf team Adam Earned two All-County Honors ('96 and '99) and Earned two All-State honors ('97 and '98). As a Freshman Adam won the 1996 Nassau County Golf Championship and Qualified for the State Championship all four years.

Upon Graduation Adam enrolled at Binghamton University. He was a two-time team captain and graduated holding the school records for lowest single-season scoring average (74.2), career average (74.7), tournament wins (10) and top-10 finishes (36). During his career he led Binghamton to 22 tournament wins and remarkable win percentage of 85%. As a senior he led BU to a Division 1 NCAA Championship berth—the first in school history. He also earned All-Region and All-American Scholar during his Junior and Senior Seasons.

AS A FRESHMAN HE WAS NAMED BINGHAMTON UNIVERSITY ATHLETE OF THE YEAR AND AS A SENIOR EARNED THE JOHN BILOS AWARD FOR ACHIEVEMENT. HE WAS INDUCTED INTO THE BINGHAMTON ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME IN 2010.

HE GRADUATED FROM BINGHAMTON UNIVERSITY WITH A BACHELOR'S OF SCIENCE IN FINANCE.

ADAM CURRENTLY IS THE OWNER OF ABBE LUMBER, A BUILDING MATERIAL BUSINESS LOCATED IN NEW JERSEY.

ADAM IS CURRENTLY ENGAGED TO REBECCA DROPKIN AND HE HAS A SON NAMED RYAN (8).



DANIEL WAS BORN IN BROOKLYN, NY IN 1935 AND ATTEND ALEXANDER HAMILTON HS.

AFTER GRADUATING HIGH SCHOOL DANIEL ATTENDED MANHATTAN COLLEGE FROM 1954-1957 ON A BASKETBALL SCHOLARSHIP. AS A MEMBER OF THE JASPER'S BASKETBALL TEAM HE HELPED THE TEAM TO A 65-32 RECORD AND 2 NIT AND 2 NCAA APPEARANCES.

IN 1957 HE BEGAN HIS 35 YEAR PHYSICAL EDUCATION TEACHING CAREER IN THE POB DISTRICT AT THE JOYCE ROAD SCHOOL. DURING HIS TENURE IN POB HE ALSO WORKED AT THE MANETTO HILL SCHOOL, OAK DR., CENTRAL PARK ROAD, POBMS, MATTLIN MS, PLAINVIEW HIGH SCHOOL AND JOHN F. KENNEDY HIGH SCHOOL. HE WAS THE 1ST CHAIRPERSON OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND HELD THAT POSITION FROM 1970-1992. HE WAS ALSO INSTRUMENTAL IN CREATING THE SUMMER SWIM AND CAMP PHYSICAL EDUCATION PROGRAM FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION STUDENTS.

DURING HIS TIME IN THE PLAINVIEW DISTRICT COACH MARTINSEN COACHED THE JV AND VARSITY BASEBALL AND BASKETBALL TEAMS AT KENNEDY HIGH SCHOOL. HE WAS THE HEAD VARSITY BASEBALL COACH FOR 20 YEARS SPANNING FROM 1971 TO 1991. HE LED KENNEDY HIGH SCHOOL BASEBALL TEAM TO A LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP IN 1979. HE ALSO EARNED THE UMPIRES ASSOCIATION HONOR COOPERATION AWARD.

AFTER HE RETIRED FROM TEACHING DANIEL PLAYED IN THE SENIOR NASSAU SOFTBALL LEAGUE FOR 12 YEARS WITH THE HUNTINGTON COUGARS. HE WAS INDUCTED INTO THE LONG ISLAND SOFTBALL HALL OF FAME IN 2004.

MITCHEL WAS A 3 YEAR VARSITY PLAYER AT JOHN F. KENNEDY HIGH SCHOOL. DURING HIS SOCCER CAREER HE HELPED THE BOYS' SOCCER TEAM TO A 37-12-3 RECORD AND TWO NORTH SHORE LEAGUE TITLES (1976 AND 1977).

HE FINISHED HIS CAREER WITH 60 GOALS, WHICH STILL STAND AS A SCHOOL RECORD TODAY. HE IS ALSO 2ND ALL-TIME IN POINTS WITH 74. HE LED HIS TEAM IN POINTS AND GOALS IN ALL THREE OF HIS SEASONS AT KENNEDY. MITCHEL WAS ALSO SELECTED ALL-COUNTY IN 1976 AND 1977


