Reopening Plans & FAQ's

Grade K–6 Art Reopening Plans

In–School Students

In–school students will receive Art instruction in their general education classroom. Art teachers will travel to and from classrooms and complete all Art projects in–person with students. Art supplies will be separated into personal student storage bags, and stored in the classroom for Art instruction periods.

Remote Students

Remote students will receive Art instruction online, utilizing Google Classroom with an Art teacher. Art teachers will prepare lessons online, and provide synchronous (live) instruction as per their remote learning schedule. Art supplies and materials will be distributed to all remote learners the week of September 8.

Grade 7–12 Art Reopening Plans

In–School Students

In–school students will receive Art instruction in their assigned Art classroom, during their assigned instructional in–school days. Students will be appropriately distanced within the Art room, and required to wear masks during instruction. All Art supplies and materials will be individually distributed. Students will also receive an Art “to–go” bag, fully stocked with appropriate Art supplies to work on projects from home. These bags may need to be “restocked” as projects change and supply needs differ from project to project.

Remote Students

Remote students will receive Art instruction online, utilizing Google Classroom with their assigned Art teacher. Art teachers will prepare lessons online, and be live with students as per their remote learning schedule. Art supplies and materials will be distributed to all remote learners the week of September 8, 2020 via the Grade 7–12 Art “to–go” bags. These bags will be supplied with appropriate materials and supplies for multiple projects.

Frequently Asked Questions	Art Department Response
Will 7–12 art students be receiving their own supplies or a list to shop for so that remote days they can complete work?	Grade 7–12 Art students will receive Art “to–go” bags with appropriate art materials to complete projects at home on remote learning days.
How will Art supplies be handled in K–6 classrooms for in–school students?	Art supplies will be separated and distributed to individual students via clear drawstring bags in the K–6 classrooms. Art supplies will not be shared.
Will remote learners be given Art supplies?	Yes, all remote students (K–12) will receive Art supplies. These supplies will be distributed by school.
