The increase in DW Athletic Equipment code is due to wall padding in the POB-JFK HS Gym, new sound system at POB-JFK Turf Field, team benches for MS fields, tennis windscreens, etc.

The increase in DW Contractual and other code is due to the purchase of 2 new AEDs for the district and increase in our AED service contract

The increase in the PE instructional code is directly related to an increase of costs for field trips that run through the PE Elementary and Middle Schools

The increase in the Supplies-Clubs code is due to the moving of the Athletic trainer supplies here, increase in bowling alley and golfing green fees, award dinner fees

The increase in the Supplies-Athletics code is due to the current inflation cost associated with the supplies needed to outfit the District's 98 athletic teams
