Physical Distancing	K-6: Barriers and/or 6-ft distance between students/staff 7-12: 6-ft distance all staff and students.	No Barriers (K-12): At least 3-ft between all students 6-ft distance between and among staff and students if longer than 15 minutes
Close Contact	Students/Staff within 6-ft for more than 15 minutes identified as close contacts and must quarantine for 10-14 days	Students are identified as a close contact if within 3-ft of an infected person for more than 15 minutes within a 24-hour period Staff are identified as a close contact if within 6-ft of an infected person for more than 15 minutes within a 24-hour period
Quarantine	Close contacts were quarantined for 10-14 days	Persons identified as close contacts must quarantine for 10 days Exception: Vaccinated individuals do not need to quarantine unless symptomatic; however should be tested 3-5 days after exposure and wear a mask indoors for 14 days
Masks	All students and staff wear masks, with mask breaks for students (up to 10 minutes) Adjusted to permit mask-free students and staff outdoors	Masks for all students and staff indoors; no masks outdoors Masks for all on busses Mask breaks for staff and students Mask break for staff only if 6ft can be maintained and under 15 minutes throughout time with students
Lockers	No locker use	Locker use in halls and locker rooms
Remote Instruction	Remote provided for all students who were medically fragile, resided with a medically fragile person, and/or were uncomfortable Remote Instruction for all during school closure, quarantine and/or isolation	Homebound instruction for medically fragile students Remote instruction via synchronous learning during school closure Homebound Instruction for quarantine and isolated students due to COVID-19

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Transportation	One student per seat, 6 ft distance between students and driver	Two students per seat with universal masking for all students and staff
School Schedules	K-8 Staggered Arrivals 7-12 Hybrid/ Alt-day in-person Option for daily in-person offered in May 2020.	Return to traditional school schedules
Daily Health Screener	Daily health screeners completed and submitted to schools by all students, staff, and visitors to building	Daily health questionnaire answered at home, not submitted to school
Nutrition	K-6 Lunch in classrooms 7-12 Lunch in cafeterias, students 6ft apart	K-12 lunch in cafeterias and alternate cafeterias All students 6 ft apart
Facilities	Daily cleaning and disinfecting Routine disinfecting of high touch areas throughout the day Areas with a confirmed case of COVID, closed for 24 hours and disinfected	Daily cleaning and disinfecting Routine disinfecting of high touch areas throughout the day Areas with a confirmed case of COVID, cleared and disinfected as soon as possible to return location for original use
Communication	Daily updates to community when there was a positive case. Reporting to NYSDOH for the Daily COVID-19 School Report Card	Notify classroom when there is a positive case (like other communicable diseases) Posting of daily cases on District website.
