Thank you for your efforts related to the COVID-19 outbreak in our area. We understand this is a difficult time for all families, but appreciate your continued, active effort during the crisis. The Plainview-Old Bethpage Central School District has partnered with SCOPE Education Services to provide Emergency Child Care to our district residents who are first responders and medical care providers. Any parent/guardian in our district who is a first responder or medical personnel critical to the response effort who needs childcare is eligible to enroll in the SCOPE child care program beginning Monday, March 30, 2020.

Child care centers are conveniently located in Hicksville and Syosset; however, SCOPE is also operating in other neighborhoods and the complete list of child care locations can be accessed at:

SCOPE Emergency Child Care enrollment is on a first-come, first-serve basis and enrollment may be limited based on space and/or staffing. Children must be school age Pre-K (must have turned 4 by 12/1/2019)-Grade 6. Priority will be given to the families of the school district in which the program is held.
