


<u>Problem</u>: Pet fish owners are releasing their fish into the wild. These pet in our waters are called invasive species. This causes a disruption in the environment. Food chains are altered, habitats become destroyed, and populations of sea life are either in risk of becoming extinct, or the population is too large and becoming out of control.

<u>Challenge</u>: Create an informational announcement (brochure, video, poster, pamphlet, newspaper article, song, artwork, etc.) that explains what an invasive species is, and that tells why releasing a fish into water forms is not safe, or a good choice for the environment. These public service announcements will be available at fish pet stores to inform and warn owners.

invasive species: a plant, fungus, or animal **species** that is not native to a specific location and which can cause damage to the environment, or humans.

species: a group of closely related organisms

native: from a certain place (like the United States)

water forms: parts of Earth made up by water (ocean, bay, river, lake, etc.)
