- When should I take?
 - **SAT**: November 2; December 7; March 8, **March 12- for POB Juniors ONLY;** May 3; June 7
 - ACT: October 26; December 14; February 8; April 5; June 14**
 - To register: <u>www.collegeboard.org</u>; <u>www.actstudent.org</u>

SAT and/or ACT

- How do I prepare?

 - <u>Princeton Review</u>
 - Virtual Resources:
 - College Board and ACT websites: <u>Khan Academy</u> (FREE)
 - Castle Learning: Methodize (FREE for POBJFK Students)

SAT and/or ACT

- Testing accommodations
 - Parent Consent Forms-- <u>College Board</u> and <u>ACT</u>
 - College Board apply once!
 - For ACT: Register for exam first, then provide ACT ID on consent form
 - All testing is separately reviewed and approved by College Board and ACT
 - Note deadlines!
- Applying to college...
 - Student is responsible to send official score report

- -Counselors Use Resume to Assist Them in Writing Letter of Recommendation

- -Campus & Virtual Visits
- -College Fair- March 27th at POBJFKHS
- -Interviews- on and off campus
 - On-Site Admissions
- -Appropriate communication
 - Online and in person
 - Cameras on!
- -Speak to college reps visiting our school
 - 10th period, check Naviance for schedule

College Decision Deadlines Early Action:

Apply early (for example: 10/15, 11/1 or 11/15) and you are notified early (typically by the end of December)

You can apply to many schools EA and make your decision by May 1st

Early Decision:

Binding agreement - you can only apply to 1 school ED

If you get accepted to your ED school you must go

Similar timeline as Early Action

College Decision Deadlines Continued

Regular Decision:

Later application deadline typically January or February

Notified of decision typically March and April

Rolling Admissions:

No actual deadline - continuously reviewing applications as they come in

Earlier is better - school will accept applications until they fill up

Timeline of Responsibilities: Junior Year

September / October / November:


- Register and take the Preliminary SAT (PSAT)
- Attend the Junior Night

December:

Review PSAT results

January / February:

- Prepare for college entrance exams (SAT and/or ACT)
- Complete Brag Sheet in preparation for Junior Conference
- ☐ Create Common App account
- Register for <u>SAT</u> / <u>ACT</u>
- ☐ Choose your senior year courses carefully



Timeline of Responsibilities Continued...

March / April / May / June:

- Attend your individual Junior Conference with your School Counselor
- Attend the POBJFK College Fair, Junior Round Table and College Essay Workshop
- ☐ Request letters of recommendation from teachers
- Visit colleges
- Plan to participate in enriching summer activities, such as volunteer work, acquiring a meaningful job or internship, enrolling in summer courses at college, etc.
- ☐ Student Athletes should register with the <u>NCAA Eligibility Center</u> and use <u>CoreCourseGPA.com</u> to track eligibility

July / August:

- ☐ Read all literature received at your Junior Conference
- ☐ Review college essay topics
- ☐ Link your Naviance account to CommonApp by signing the FERPA Agreement

What Do I Do Now?

- Self-reflect:
 - What makes you happy? How do you enjoy spending your free time? How do you learn best? What environment are you most comfortable in?
- Familiarize with <u>Naviance Student</u>
- Research and plan visits to college campuses
- Communicate with your school counselor!
