ABOUT OUR SCHOOL

Plainview Old Bethpage John F. Kennedy High School is a four-year secondary school (Grades 9-12). In addition to the high school, the district encompasses two middle schools (Grades 5-8) and four elementary schools (Grades K-4).

THE COMMUNITY

The combined hamlets of Plainview and Old Bethpage (population approximately 32,000) are centrally located on Long Island, approximately 35 miles east of New York City. The adult residents of the community are comprised predominately of business and professional people. The community has established a reputation for its support of excellence in education.

COURSE WEIGHTING

Honors and college classes are weighted by an additional 5%, Advanced Placement classes by an additional 7%, only when calculating cumulative average.
