# **Scholarships**

### 1. Excelsior Scholarship

- Description: The Excelsior Scholarship provides eligible New York residents with tuitionfree access to SUNY (State University of New York) and CUNY (City University of New York) colleges.
- **Eligibility**: Students must have a family income of \$125,000 or less and agree to live and work in New York State for the same number of years they receive the scholarship.

# 2. Enhanced Tuition Awards (ETA)

- Description: This program provides financial assistance to students attending private
  colleges in New York. The award can provide up to \$6,000 through a combination of
  state funding, college matching funds, and a tuition credit.
- **Eligibility**: Available to New York State residents with a household income of \$125,000 or less.

# 3. NYS Tuition Assistance Program (TAP)

- **Description**: TAP is one of the largest financial aid programs in New York, providing grants to eligible New York residents to help pay tuition at approved colleges within the state.

# 4. STEM Incentive Program

#### 5. NYS Aid for Part-Time Study (APTS)

- **Description**: This program provides financial aid for part-time undergraduate students enrolled in eligible New York State colleges.
- **Eligibility**: Applicants must be New York residents, enrolled in at least 3 but less than 12 credits per semester, and meet income eligibility criteria.

### 6. New York State Memorial Scholarships
