 - Emergency Drills/Administrative Coverage/Updates
 - Mr. Scesney will make Chris Donarummo's BOE meeting presentation available for staff and parents.
 - JJP will be getting more security cameras, as well as, strobe lights in the cafeteria and gym (louder areas of the building) and outside the building which will be illuminated during a lockdown drill.
 - JJP's third lockdown drill for the year is complete. Laurie Lynn, Meredythe Alliegro, Jeff Yagaloff, and Chris Donarummo were in the building for the drill.
 - POP officers from the Nassau County Police Department have observed JJP lockdown drills and have been asked to come back.
 - Observations of JJP's lockdown drills have been positive and the building clears quickly and all door lock efficiently.
- New Furniture for spaces, STEAM room
 - New furniture, which was purchased by Central Administration, has been delivered to JJP. The furniture will be used in the STEAM room as well as in the current ENL and Math rooms in the new addition. There are plans to move ENL to the second wing of the building and convert all of the new space to a Math Lab.
- Memorials for Linda Lippolt and Gina O'Heir, Book Room
 - Applebee's Flapjack Breakfast raised \$2800 for the Linda Lippolt Scholarship.
 - Staff would like to create a book room at JJP named after Gina O'Heir. Books would be purchased through donations made by JJP families. The books would be labeled, for example, "From The Starr Family."
 - PTA will discuss ways of donating to the book room as well. Some suggestions would be to purchase books using Scholastic Money from Book Fair, having parents purchase books at Book Fair to donate to the book room.
 - PTA will work with staff to help create and stock the book room.
 - PTA will speak with John Laub regarding the planting of a tree in memory of Linda Lippolt.
- New Business
 - Questions from PTA regarding security at JJP. Is it possible to have double-doors installed at the beginning of the first wing, similar to the doors which separate the first wing from the Library and Computer rooms? The first wing would then only be accessible if buzzed in or a key fob was used. A request to make the back parking lot a

staff-only lot with a gate was also discussed. The lot buffers the playground which is used for rec and gym and also where visitors park.
