

## Stratford Road Elementary School Site Based- April 18, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 8:35am Diversity and Inclusivity Discussion 1. There is a continuation of a discussion from our previous meeting regarding how to ensure all members of our diverse school community are included (and can understand written school communications). 2. Alison Clark will be reaching out to Central Office to inquire about additional language translation options for School Messenger Notifications. 3. The PTA will explore getting representatives from as many diverse communities as possible to be at Back to School Night to sign people up for PTA Eblasts, PTA, and serve as informal interpreters and emissaries of the PTA. Building Updates 1. The adult and student bathrooms in the front of the building will be made ADA compliant. (summer 2019) 2. Ceiling and Lighting replacements will be done in the hallways and 28 rooms. The hallway by the Gymnasium was recently done and will not be re-done. (summer 2019) 3. Electric Hand-Dryers will be installed in the student bathrooms. (summer 2019) 4. A new Public Address (PA) System will be installed with coverage of all areas. (summer 2019) 5. Fire System Upgrade (summer 2019) 6. Replacement of Doors (which will include being installed with the SALTO locking system) (fall 2019). Currently this project has been or is in the process of being completed at all the other elementary schools. 7. Boiler Replacement (currently happening) 8. Masonry Work (summer 2019) 9. Replacement of Windows (begin during the 19-20 school year or summer 2020) 10. Addition of upstairs adult restroom. Plans are currently with NYSED. (possibly during 19-20 school year) 11. Air Conditioning of Auditorium (2020) Budget Adopted with some Revisions 1. Increase in Mental Health Support with addition of a District-Wide Mental Health Interventionist. The hours of this employee are to be determined but may focus on the later part of/after traditional school hours. 2. Addition of a K-4 Behaviorist. 3. Breakage positions were added to replace ones already used at other schools. 4. Discovery Lab position expanded to full-time. Potential for 4 trips per grade. 5. We already have a lot of supports in place to identify students at risk. These include Go Guardian, Say Something, and Scholar Chip. Go Guardian- On all chrome books. An alert is sent to principal if a student is accessing inappropriate websites or search terms. A screenshot is taken of student's screen and a log of sites visited before and after is available. Say Something- Part of the Sandy Hook Promise. Anonymous reporting APP. Tips/Issues evaluated, and appropriate staff are notified. Scholar Chip- All visitors are screened when entering a building. If an alert is generated for someone on a Sex Offender Registry an administrator verifies if it is a true match. The meeting was adjourned at 9:00am. Our final meeting is May 6th .
