Classroom teachers will provide their direct instruction using their individual methods of communication (such as email, Google Classroom, Zoom, Remind, or Class Dojo).

Additionally, Mrs. Winters and I will be hosting Parent Chats via Zoom on Thursdays- 10:30am-11:30am and 3:00pm-4:00pm. The link to join the meeting will be sent via email on Wednesday. The purpose of the Parent Chats is to check-in with you and answer any general questions; we are here to provide support while venturing into new modes of learning. Please remember, as always, questions should be directed to your teachers first. They can help you with specific concerns about your children, the curriculum, and expectations.

We understand that there may be questions about upcoming and year-end events; at this time, we have no further information beyond the new directives given by Governor Cuomo that schools remain closed until April 15. Continued communication will come from Dr. Lewis, Superintendent. Thank you for your patience, understanding, and support as we navigate through new territory.
