As you are aware, New York State passed the [Senator Jose Peralta DREAM Act](#). The DREAM Act allows undocumented and other students access to state-administered grants, including the [Tuition Assistance Program \(TAP\)](#), [Excelsior Scholarship](#), and other [state-administered](#) scholarships.

CUNY ASAP strongly supports all non-FAFSA filers interested in ASAP to check their eligibility and complete the application for the [NYS DREAM Act](#). Additionally, [TheDream.US National Scholarship](#) application is open for DREAMers who live in states where they are eligible to pay in-state tuition at a partner college.
