To help resolve common Chromebook issues, please find the following directions to help you troubleshoot your Chromebook from home:

## 1) Verify the latest version of ChromeOS is installed:

- 1. Turn on your Chromebook.
- 2. Connect your Chromebook to Wi-Fi.
- 3. At the bottom right, select the time.
- 4. Select Settings .
- 5. At the bottom of the left panel, select **About Chrome OS**.
- 6. Under "Google Chrome OS," you'll find which version of the Chrome operating system your Chromebook uses.
- 7. Select Check for updates.
- 8. If your Chromebook finds a software update, it will start to download automatically.

## 2) Power wash the Chromebook:

- 1. Sign out of your Chromebook.
- 2. Press and hold Ctrl + Alt + Shift + r.
- 3. Select Restart.
- 4. In the box that appears, select Powerwash > Continue.
- 5. After the device is finished power washing, enter your WiFi information and proceed through the prompts.
- 6. Sign back in and verify the issue is resolved
