

What Good Readers Do

- Set aside time to read
- Use embedded text to help understand what they are reading
- Stop and think about what they read
- Connect books to other books, personal experiences, or world ideas to deepen their reading experience
- Reread
- Self monitor their reading
- Infer (“read between the lines”)
- Predict
- Have questions or “I Wonder’s” while they read
- Talk and write about what they are reading
- Read different genres and understand how they work
- Use context clues and visualize to understand difficult words
- Relate to/compare/contrast characters
- Use background knowledge and prior experiences to further understand the text
- Comprehend what they read
- Challenge themselves
