Boys' Soccer—Nassau County Champions!!!

The Plainview-Old Bethpage Boys' Varsity Soccer team started the season with a goal, to host and win a home playoff game. They accomplished this goal when they defeated the Hempstead Tigers 1-0 on a cool October night. The Hawks didn't just stop there though, instead they did something that no Boys' Soccer team had accomplished since 1985, they were crowned the 2022 CLASS AA NASSAU COUNTY BOYS' SOCCER CHAMPIONS!

After the Hempstead game the Hawks headed to Mitchell Field five days later for a semi-final match up versus Port Washington. The Hawks lost to the Vikings earlier this season 0-1 but Asher Block scored the game's only goal and the Hawks got revenge this time with a 1-0 win.

The Nassau County Championship game would be one for the ages. The Hawks were facing the #1 seed Oceanside. In late September the Hawks lost to Oceanside 0-2, but once again the Hawks would prevail 1-0 in double overtime when Weber Nakagawa-Duarte headed home a cross from Ryan Misiti late in the second overtime.

That goal earned the Plainview-Old Bethpage Boys' Soccer team their third Nassau County championship in school history and the program's first since 1985.

The Hawks would fall short in the next round but nothing could take away what this group of young men achieved this year.

The Hawks finished the season with a 14-4-1 record. As a team they scored 41 goals and gave up only 15 on the season for a goal differential of +26. Senior Asher Block (16 goals and 5 assists) and Sophomore Weber Nakagawa-Duarte (13 goals and 3 assists) helped spearhead the offensive attack. Sophomore Ryan Misiti lead the team in assists with 8. Junior goalie Ben Selmer had 9 shutouts for the season.

The Hawks took home some individual honors as well, Asher Block earned All–Region. Weber Nakagawa-Duarte and Senior Sean Lee earned All-County. Sophomore Christopher Simonian earned All-County Honorable Mention. Ryan Misiti, Juniors Anthony Powers and Zachary Hammerman along with Freshman Connor Faello earned All-Conference honors.

As a junior she led the NE10 in digs (585) and digs/set (5.63), she was also named the ECAC defensive player of the month (September) and was named Libero of the week 4 times. In her career at Adelphi she was named the NE10 Libero of the year (2021,2022), CoSIDA Academic All-District (2021), NE10 Academic All-Conference (2021), NE10 Academic Honor Roll - Academic Distinction (Fall '20), NE10 Academic Honor Roll - Academic Honors (Spring '21, Fall '21). As a freshman at NYIT Jamie earned East Coast Conference Libero of Year, AVCA East Region and ECC Rookie of the Year (Second Team All-East Region and AVCA All-East Region Honorable Mention and Named NYIT Freshman Woman Athlete of the Year.

This season the Boys' Volleyball Team finished with a record of 9-9. The Hawks advanced to the Quarter finals of the Nassau County Class A playoffs. This was the first time in a few seasons they reached this level, but they lost a heart-breaking 5th set 15-13 against Farmingdale. The following Hawks received All-County Awards; Sean Farrell and Aiden Gasbarro. The Following Hawks received All-Conference Awards; Jacob Adler and Geoffrey Rothschild. Aadi Shah was recognized by Nassau County as a Scholar Athlete and Alex Berko was recognized as an Unsung Hero. Many players on the team were ranked in stats for Nassau County; Sean Farrell 196 Kills, Geoffrey Rothschild 480 Assists, Aiden Gasbarro 214 Digs.

Girls' Volleyball



The Girls' Varsity Volleyball team finished with a conference record of 8-6. The Hawks defeated the Baldwin Bruins 3-0 in their quarterfinal playoff game, but fell short against Massapequa in the county semifinals. The girls took home a number of county awards, including All-County for senior setter Jordyn Rubin, All-County Honorable Mention for junior outside hitter Sarah Fisher and junior libero Ella Katz, and All-Conference for junior outside hitter Maddy Laucella. In addition, Sofie Nelson took home County Scholar-Athlete recognition. During the season, Jordyn Rubin surpassed 1,000 career assists, something that cements her in the Hawks' history books. Although the Hawks will miss the presence of their All-County setter next year, they look forward to an exciting season as they move into AAA classification.
