Dear Parents and Guardians,

The winter interscholastic athletic season is upon us and I can't wait to see the Hawks in action. In order to maintain a safe environment for all in attendance we ask that everyone follow these safety procedures.

- 1) Masks are mandated and must be worn the entire game
- 2) No food will be allowed inside the gymnasium or on the pool deck.
- 3) Social Distance Guidelines
 - a) Students must sit 3' apart

b) Adults must sit 6' apart - Family members are allowed to sit together.

<u>POB-JFK HS Pool</u> - A maximum of 24 home spectators will be allowed onto the pool deck. Admission will be on a first come, first serve basis. No visiting fans will be allowed at the meets.

POB-JFK HS Gym - A maximum of 260 students will be allowed to attend games/matches. A maximum of 196 family and friends will be allowed to attend games/ matches. Students will be seated in the two large bleacher sections, while family and friends will be seated in the two smaller bleacher sections. Admission will be on a first come, first serve basis.

<u>POBMS Pool</u> - A maximum of 24 home spectators will be allowed onto the pool deck. Admission will be on a first come, first serve basis. No visiting fans will be allowed at the meets.

POBMS Gym - A maximum of 60 home spectators will be allowed into the gym. Admission will be on a first come, first serve basis.

<u>Mattlin Gym -</u> A maximum of 60 home spectators will be allowed into the gym. Admission will be on a first come, first serve basis.

<u>Stratford Road</u> - A maximum of 60 home spectators will be allowed into the gym. Admission will be on a first come, first serve basis.

Jamaica Ave - A maximum of 24 home spectators will be allowed into the gym. Admission will be on a first come, first serve basis. No visiting fans will be allowed at the meets.
