# RIGHT-OF-WAY

Whenever present, all drivers must obey:

---

Drivers must yield to \_\_\_\_\_ legally using marked or unmarked crosswalks.

A driver approaching an intersection must \_\_\_\_\_ to traffic already in the intersection.

If drivers approaching from opposite directions reach an intersection at about the same time, \_\_\_\_\_ must yield to approaching traffic going straight or turning right.

At intersections not controlled by sign or signals, or where two or more drivers at right angles to one another stop at STOP signs at the same time, the driver on the \_\_\_\_\_ must yield to the driver on the \_\_\_\_\_.

A driver entering a traffic circle, [rotary], must yield the right-of way to \_\_\_\_\_
