


#### Distribution of 2018 Graduates






### **Graduation Rates**

#### **% Passing 2018 Advanced Placement Exams**




#### Student Performance Highlights


- 434 graduates earned over \$10 million in scholarships

## Highlights

- Completed CISCO IP phone system backend upgrade comprised of servers, voice gateways, and handset code updates to support all buildings
- Restructured District NOC cabling and added additional file storage, UPS
- Integrated Digital Signage, Scholar-Chip security systems and IP Cameras
- Implemented Class-Link/One-Roster Single-Sign-On and Auto Rostering
- NYSED approval of Smart Schools Bond Investment/Technology Plan

#### Facilities, Transportation & Security

- Wireless networks are being completed in all school buildings
- District-wide security camera project completed
- Air conditioning 100% complete at Judy Jacobs Parkway and Pasadena. More air conditioning projects underway at Old Bethpage, Stratford Road, POBMS, MMS and POBJFK HS
- Visitor Screening system is implemented
- Budget includes security enhancements such as after-hours security camera monitoring and dispatch, strengthened entry vestibules and 1st floor window films
- Track lighting installed at POBMS. New sports courts opened at Stratford Road
- One button lockdown system underway for 2018-2019
- PPS, Athletics, Technology and Child Care move to Stratford Road Administrative Annex

- AAA Bond Rating continues

- Multi-year plan for District reserves presented and posted to website
