IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS AND STUDENTS PLEASE READ AND SIGN BELOW

The following rules and regulations will govern the PLAINVIEW-OLD BETHPAGE Driver Education Program. They should be read and signed by the student and parent/guardian.

ABSENCES

The semester is comprised of a total of 16 instructional days or a total of 48 hours. The NYS Education Department Guidelines for Driver and Traffic Safety Education require a <u>minimum of 24 clock hours of</u> <u>classroom instruction (lecture) and 24 clock hours of laboratory (in-car) instruction</u>. This means that a student must attend <u>all 48 hours</u> of this program in order to receive a Certificate of Completion (blue card). One makeup date will be provided for absences due to <u>emergency</u>. Otherwise, <u>no absences are permitted</u>. <u>Check the list</u> of dates on the reverse of this sheet to be certain that absences will not occur.

Keep in mind Driver Education requirements are New York State mandated. Students will not be able to participate in clubs and/or sports that meet during the assigned lecture and driving time.

LIMITATIONS OF A JUNIOR LICENSE

A student who is still 16 and passes a road test, even if he/she has successfully completed the Driver Education Program, is still limited by a Junior License and the following restrictions apply in Nassau/Suffolk Counties:

- 1. The student may drive a vehicle appropriate to his/her license directly to or from a state approved cooperative work-study program. Carry form MV-287A with the license.
- 2. The student may drive directly to or from an approved program for credit at a post secondary institution, college, or university. Carry form MV~287A with the license.
- 3. The student may drive directly to or from a state approved registered evening high school. Carry form MV~287A with a license.
- 4. The student may drive directly to or from an approved driver education course. Carry form MV-287A with the license.
- 5. The student may drive a vehicle unaccompanied directly to or from work between 5 AM and 9 PM. Carry form MV-58A with the license.
- 6. If enrolled in a driver education course, he/she may drive a vehicle accompanied by his/her licensed parent or professional driving instructor between 5 AM and 9 PM.

PLEASE NOTE: An interpretation of the above guidelines basically prohibits students from driving to and from high school without a parent until regular operator's privileges are obtained at age 17 and the student has received a Certificate of Completion (blue card). A student who has only a Permit and is enrolled in a driver education course may drive a vehicle <u>only</u> when accompanied by a licensed parent or professional driving instructor between 5:00 AM and 9:00 PM.

We have read, understand and accept the guidelines, responsibilities and obligations as outlined above, especially with regard to <u>ABSENCES</u> and <u>CLUB/SPORT CONFLICTS</u>.
