Training Topics Due by Monday, September 30, 2021

Discrimination and Harassment for Employees and Supervisors

(30-minutes)

New York State legislation mandates all employers establish a sexual harassment policy and conduct annual employee training in sexual harassment. This course meets the requirements and is compliant with the regulations set forth in this legislation and by the NYS Division of Human Rights. This course will assist school districts and BOCES to meet their obligations to ensure that all staff members are able to work in an environment free from discrimination and harassment.

Bloodborne Pathogens & Standard Precautions Training Program

(30-minutes)

This program is designed to meet the training requirements of 29CFR1910.1030 and New York State Department of Labor requirements.

Hazard Communication Training: Right to Know

(*30-minutes*)

This course covers the Hazard Communication Standard. It is one of the Public Employee Safety and Health Bureau's most violated standards. This standard gives employees who work with Hazardous Chemicals "Right to Know" about these chemicals and their associated hazards.

Preventing Phishing

(15-minutes)

Phishing remains the single biggest threat to information security, and if employees continue to take the bait, this course can address that problem with this training that directly targets the kind of behaviors that need to change. This engaging course helps people identify the ways that scammers attempt to get into their system and offers practical advice and practice on avoiding phishing attempts on all kinds of devices.

The Dignity for All Students Act

(30-minutes)

The course is designed to help school district employees involved in direct student services understand the implications of the Dignity Act and how to respond to incidents of bullying and harassment.

Suicide Prevention and Evidence Based Risk Factors

(60-minutes)

In this training module, the following areas are covered: The Suicide Challenge; Evidence-Based Suicide Risk Factors; Assessing At-Risk Adolescents; and Red Flags and Action.
