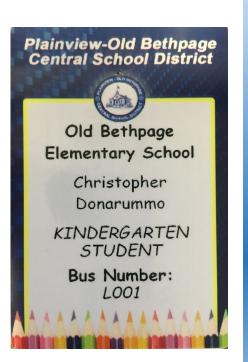

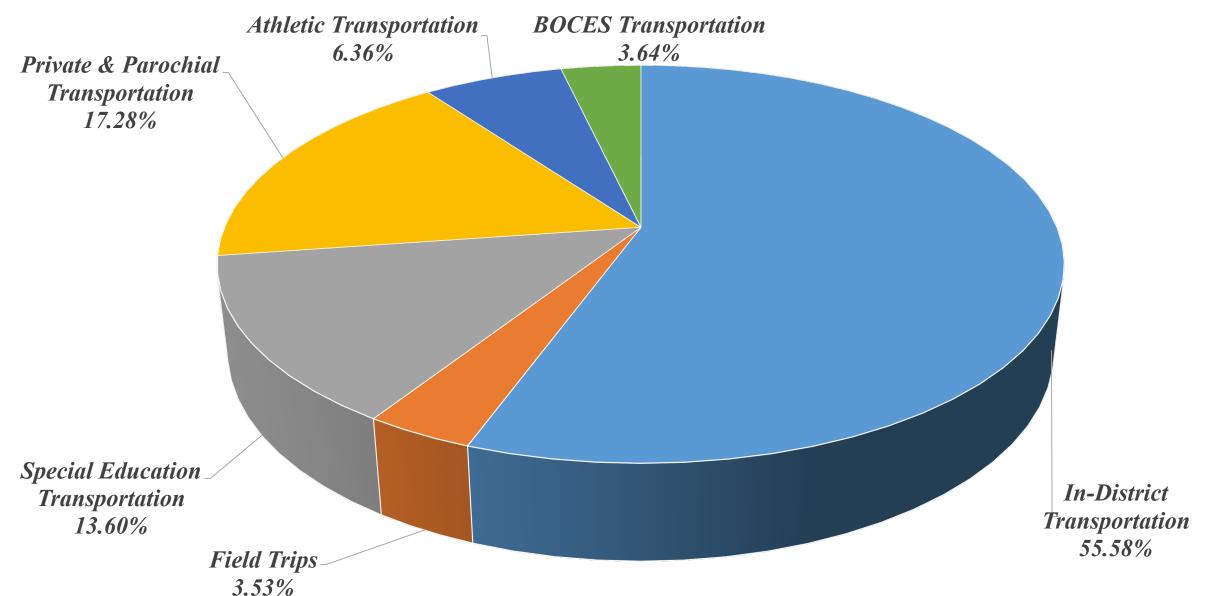

Transportation Budget Supports...

Daily Transportation of Approximately 5,300 Students

- In-District, Out-of-District & Private/Parochial Schools
- 30 bus attendants with specialized training to support the individual needs of students
- Revised 11th period routes at the high school
- Revised field trip system (Bus Hive) & elementary dismissal system (PickUp Patrol)
- Upgrading the district's transportation routing system, RouteFinder, to the Cloud
- Maintenance of four (4) district-owned transportation vehicles

Field Trip Transportation Support

- Learning opportunities outside the classroom for all students (K-12)
- Project Challenge programs at the elementary and middle school levels
- Work Study program at various work sites within the community
- Fun-Time and Special Education TAG programs (K-12)
- Transportation for the Senior Citizens to their Friday program





Moving Mountains-Health, Safety & Security

Enhanced Evening Security & Facility Use Process

- Increased security at all schools within the district
- Greater management and oversight of facility use
- Use of existing security protocols to assist with visitor management & building management

POB Command Center

- Increased coverage throughout the school day and during the evenings/weekends
- Centralized camera storage/access & updated camera software for greater functionality
- FlySense Pilot at JFK High School

Updated One-Button Lock-Down System

- Increased accessibility for students & staff
- Salto lock system at buildings within the district elimination of keys
- Automated response to secure all classrooms and offices

Continued Partnership with the Nassau County Police Department

- Implementation of the RAVE alert communication system to improve communication
- Testing of the RAVE Panic System at all schools within the district

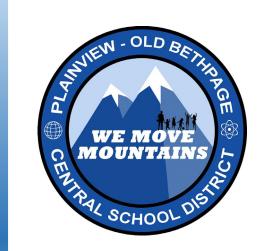
