- Adheres to Board of Education established class size guidelines
- Maintains faculty & staff
- Staffing:
 - Net neutral staffing at Old Bethpage & Judy Jacobs Parkway
 - +1 section at Pasadena
 - -2 sections at Stratford Road
 - Monitoring Kindergarten enrollment for a possible +1 section at SR
 - Monitoring ICT and ABA needs for incoming Kindergarten
 - Monitoring special class needs at Stratford Road
 - Monitoring all Kindergarten enrollment
 - Special Education: Subject to the outcomes of Annual Reviews
 - Overall, +0.4 FTE increase in elementary special education staffing
- Maintains support with K-1 support program (XR), Reading teachers and Therapist push in

K-4 Overview

Old Bethpage

- K-4 enrollment with 21 projected sections with 4 sections in grades K, 1, 3 & 4 and 5 sections of grade 2
- Average class size is projected at 20.14 (currently at 20.24)
- ICT sections in grades K-4

Judy Jacobs Parkway

- K-4 enrollment with 18 projected sections with 4 sections in grades K, 3, & 4 and 3 sections in grade 1 & 2
- Average class size is projected at 20.57 (currently at 20.97)
- ICT sections in grades 3 & 4

Pasadena

- K-4 enrollment with 22 projected sections with 4 sections in grades K, 2 & 3 and 5 sections in grades 1 & 4
- Average class size is projected at 19.22 (currently at 20.8)
- ICT sections in grade 3 & 4

Stratford Road

- K-4 enrollment with 26 sections with 5 sections in grades K, 1, 3 & 4 and 6 sections in grade 2
- Average class size is projected at 21.27 (currently at 20.65)
- ICT sections in grades K & 1 and SC sections in grades K-4

- This budget will allow us to continue the Daily Substitute program in all buildings.
