- Building leaders in technology and innovation





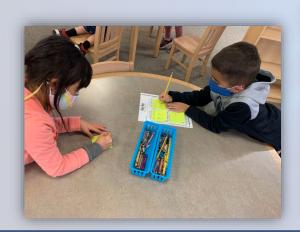






Citizenship and Safe Learning Environment

- Curation of high quality, age-appropriate resources that provide a globally diverse point of view





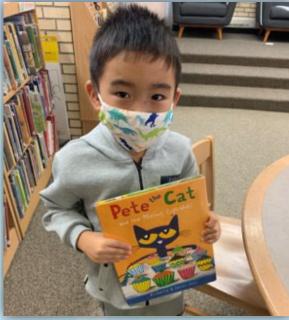


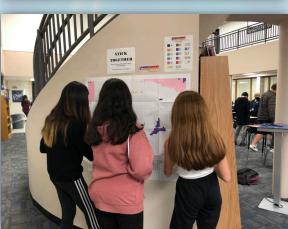
