Budget Drivers Related to 2024/25 Staffing Projections

- Preserve all academic programs, student support services, and enrichment opportunities for students (K-12)
- Support POB Points of Pride such as:
 - Health & Safety, Mental Health & Social Emotional Development
 - Academic Intervention Services (AIS) in ELA, Reading & Math
 - Project Challenge, Discovery Lab, Independent Research
 - Extra-curricular clubs, Athletics, and field-trips (local and abroad)
- Develop master schedules to maximize student opportunity while adhering to BOE class size guidelines
- Continued support of the Multi-tiered System of Support Plan (MTSS) implementation
- Continued support of technological advances (AI)
- Maintain fiscal responsibility while supporting increased student enrollment, reduced state aid, and \$5,632,391 loss in federal COVID funding
- Reduce payroll expenses through attrition (not replacing retirements and resignations), and efficient master scheduling (elimination of positions)

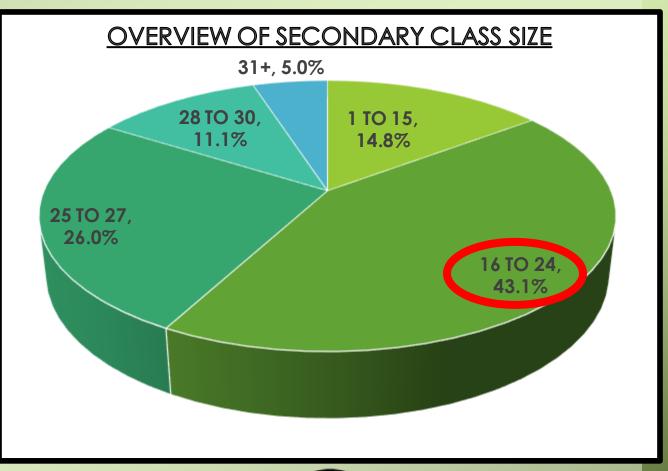
