- ✓ Worked in conjunction with the Nassau County Police Department to review building-level Lock-Down procedures at all buildings.

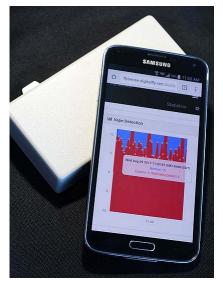

Email, text and voice notifications sent to building administration

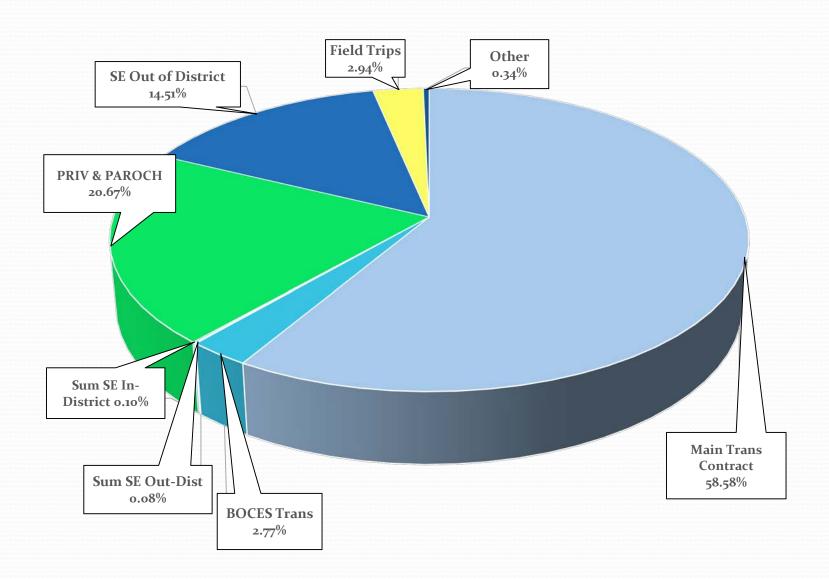
