All Intramurals will be held <u>9th Period</u> in the GYM or OUTSIDE (weather permitting)





Talent Show Information

The following guidelines <u>must</u> be followed.

1- You must audition in order to be considered as a participant. AND You may only perform in 1 "act". (This includes participation in a "group act".)

2- You must audition with the "act" you plan to perform in the actual show.

3-If your "act" requires music you must provide your own accompaniment. (This can be either a person who will accompany you on piano or a tape/cd.) Furthermore, you must have either the karaoke version or an instrumental version of the song. <u>You may</u> not sing-a-long with a prerecorded vocalist.

NO ONE WILL BE PERMITTED TO AUDITION WITHOUT ACCOMPANIMENT.

4- If your "act" requires props you must bring your own. (An example would be a juggler would supply his/her own items to juggle.)

5- THIS IS A CLOSED AUDITION. Only students from Mattlin who are auditioning may attend the audition. Parents/Guardians are asked to wait for you in the main lobby or cafeteria.

6- You must arrange to be picked up by an adult at the end of your audition.

<u>The date of the talent show is Friday, October 21, 2022. There will be a dress rehearsal Thursday, October 20, 2022, starting at 3:40, which is mandatory.</u> If you have any questions please see Mr. Olivari in classroom, D-27, at your convenience.
