School Rules and the Code of Conduct

Chromebook Usage

Chromebooks...

- are the property of the POB Central School District.
- must only be used for school work.
- are monitored by school administration.
- Google chats are **NOT** allowed!



Cell Phone Policy



- Cell phones are not allowed to be used during the school day. Do not take pictures, audio or video of any student or adult in the building.
 - Cell phones may be used at the end of the school day to make a quick phone call home then must be put away.
 - Students are not permitted to use their cell phone in the hallway or in remedial classrooms.
 - Cell phones must remain turned off and in lockers at all times.
 - Violations of the cell phone policy are considered a Code of Conduct violation and will result in disciplinary consequences.
 - Students who need to make a phone call during the day will have access to telephones in the offices of each house.
 - Parents will be able to get messages to their children through the Main Office during the school day.

Locker/Backpack Policy



- Students must prepare for upcoming periods and take the necessary materials with them. Lockers should not be used each period.
 - Students should be prepared and not ask to use their lockers during the middle of class time.
 - Student backpacks must be kept in locker and can be taken out after 8th period.

Student ID Badges

Starting in **October**, all students will be issued ID badges.

- ID badges must be worn at all times.
- Each grade has their own color.
- Each ID badge has a picture of the individual student it is issued to.
- Eventually ID badges will be used to take out library books and to pay for lunch.
