- Vandalism of school property will not be tolerated. This includes the bathroom and cafeteria.

Chromebook Usage



- Chromebooks are the property of the POB Central School District.
- They must only be used for school work.
- Must be cared for and placed in a case when not in use.
- **Must** be charged each and every day.
- Are monitored by school administration.
- Video games are not allowed.
- Do not touch anyone else's computer.





Cell Phone Policy



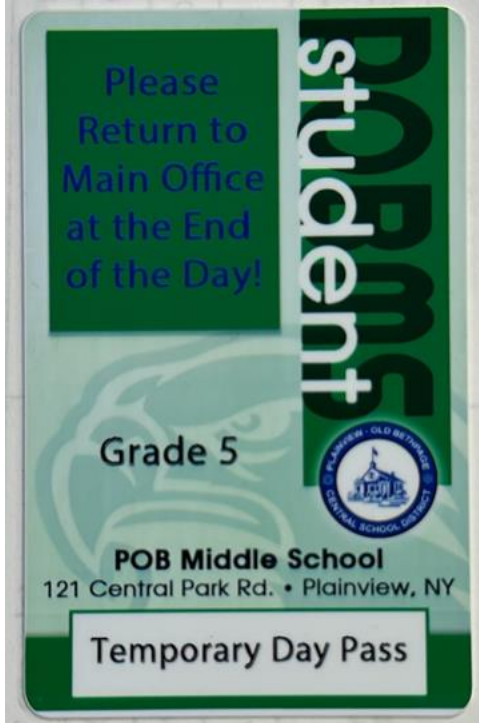
- Cell phones are not allowed to be used during the school day, including zero and ninth periods. Do not take pictures, audio or video of any student or adult in the building.
 - Cell phones may be used at the end of the school day to make a quick phone call home then must be put away.
 - Students are not permitted to use their cell phone in the hallway, cafeteria, bathroom, locker rooms, auditorium, gymnasium, MAP class, recess, and in remedial classrooms.
 - Cell phones must remain turned off and away at all times.
 - Violations of the cell phone policy are considered a Code of Conduct violation and will result in disciplinary consequences.
 - Students who need to make a phone call during the day will have access to telephones in the main office.
 - Parents will be able to get messages to their children through the Main Office during the school day.
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Locker/Backpack Policy



- Students must prepare for upcoming periods and take the necessary materials with them. Lockers should not be used each period.
- Students should be prepared and not ask to use their lockers during the middle of class time.
- Student backpacks must be kept in locker and can be taken out after 8th period.





Student ID Badges

- ID badges must be worn around the neck at all times.
- Each grade has their own color.
 - 5th Grade - Green
 - 6th Grade - Orange
 - 7th Grade - Yellow
 - 8th Grade - Red
- Each ID badge has a picture of the individual student it is issued to.
- Student pictures must be visible at all times.



POBMS is Respectful



- Respect all people - peers and adults, including Guest Teachers, Aides, Custodians, Security, and Secretaries
- Respect time - all students' classroom time is valuable. Limit bathroom and water breaks.
- Respect the environment - keep the building clean and clean up after yourself.





The Cafeteria

- Exhibit good manners at all times.
- Do Not leave the cafeteria without asking an adult first.
- Keep your lunch area clean.
- Remain seated unless you are getting food or throwing away your trash.
- Respond respectfully when addressed by an adult.
- Cell phones are prohibited during lunch.





Recess

Leave	Leave recess only with staff permission.
Play	Play games by the rules.
Get	Get help resolving a disagreement when needed.
Return	Return the equipment at the end of recess.
Stay in	Stay in appropriate areas.
Avoid	Avoid rough play that can lead to injuries.



Hallways and Staircases



- Move safely, and stay to the right.
 - **Do not run or yell.**
 - Use appropriate voice level, language, and topics.
 - Speak to school staff, students, and visitors respectfully.
 - Water bottles are a privilege - be careful not to spill.
 - Be respectful of others - classes are going on!
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Ninth Period Dismissal



- Students staying for 9th period will report to the auditorium for dismissal.
- In the auditorium you will sit in the row next to your bus letter. Each bus will be called as it arrives.

Sports...

- **If you are staying for sports, you cannot leave the school and return.** Students waiting for sports should report directly to the gym.
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Bus Stops and Riding the Bus

- The bus is an extension of school. Always follow school rules.
- Use appropriate voice level, language and topics.
- Respect other people's personal space.
- Follow bus rules and directions of the bus driver.
- Use headphones for your music.
- Clean up after yourself.
- Use technology responsibly.
