ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- The student has exhibited mathematical strengths since elementary school which are noted on the elementary report cards.
 - Consistently achieved 4s on the elementary report cards in mathematics.
 - Remarks in the comment section of the elementary report cards recognize mathematical strengths.
- The student has taken all applicable NYS math assessments and achieved a high Level 4
 on each NYS math assessment.
- The student has a 95 or better assessment average in Grade 5 in quarters 1 3.
- The student's grades in quarters 1 3 in Grade 5 are consistently above 95 in both math and science.
- Teacher feedback, which speaks to the student's ability, academic achievement, and eagerness to take on challenges, supports such advancement in mathematics.
- NWEA MAP Growth score places the student among the top national percentiles.
- The student demonstrates mastery on an in-person departmental exam that is aligned to the NYS Learning Standards and assesses the student's understanding of Math 6 concepts. (Written parental permission required.)
