## Possession is 9/10 of the law!

In Spanish there is no apostrophe "s" (David's) to show ownership or possession.

So, what do we do?

We Use a "de" construction

Use this formula:

article + noun + de or del + owner

## **Examples:**

- The girl's book
  - el libro de la chica
    - ("the book of Maria")
- The student's dictionary
  - El diccionario del estudiante
    - The dictionary of the student
