

SER	ESTAR
Permanent Condition	Temporary Condition
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ser is used to express a trait or a characteristic. Ser is used to express where someone or something is from. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Estar is used to express a temporary state or condition like emotions or health conditions. Estar is used to express where someone or something is located.

SER

The following are the forms of the verb ser:

Yo <u>soy</u>	(I am)	Nosotros <u>somos</u> (We are)
Tú <u>eres</u>	(You are)	
Él	(He is)	Ellos (They are) masc.
Ella <u>es</u>	(She is)	Ellas <u>son</u> (They are) fem.
Usted	(You are) Polite form	Ustedes (You all are)

USES OF THE VERB 'SER'

Use the verb 'ser' when you are talking about the following:

Description: Yo soy alto. (*I am tall.*); Ella es inteligente. (*She is intelligent.*)

Origin: Yo soy de los Estados Unidos. (*I am from the United States.*)

Nationality: Ellos son americanos. (*They are Americans.*)

Time: Es la una. (*It is 1:00*); Son las nueve. (*It is 9:00*)

Date: Es el cuatro de julio. (*It is July 4.*)

Occupation: Tú eres profesor. (*You are a teacher*)

ESTAR

The following are the forms of the verb estar:

Yo <u>estoy</u>	(I am)	Nosotros <u>estamos</u> (We are)
Tú <u>estás</u>	(You are)	
Él	(He is)	Ellos (They are)
Ella <u>está</u>	(She is)	Ellas <u>están</u> (They are)
Usted	(You are) Polite form	Ustedes (You all are)

USES OF THE VERB 'ESTAR'

Use the verb 'estar' when you are talking about the following:

Health: Yo estoy bien. (*I am well.*); Ella está mal. (*She is not well.*)

Emotion: Yo estoy feliz. (*I am happy.*); Él está triste. (*He is sad.*)

Location: Ellos están en la cafetería. (*They are in the cafeteria.*)

Progressive Tense: Está nevando. (*It is snowing.*); Está lloviendo. (*It is raining.*)
