

Pregunta: How do you conjugate the verb 'Ir'?

The following are the forms of the verb 'lr':

Yo <u>voy</u>	(I go)	Nosotros <u>vamos</u> (We go)
Tú <u>vas</u>	(You go)	
ÉI Ella <u>va</u> Usted	(He goes) (She goes) (You go) Polite form	Ellos (They go) Ellas <u>van</u> (They go) Ustedes (You all go)

RULES WHEN USING THE VERB 'IR'

The verb <u>ir</u> is used when talking about where people go or are going.

Examples:

I go to the beach, I am going to the beach .

Yo voy a la playa.

1. The verb 'Ir' is always followed by the preposition 'a' (to).

Ir a = to go to Example: Yo voy a la escuela.

(I go to school)

- 2. Don't forget that a + el = al Example: Ella va al supermercado.

 (She goes to the supermarket)
- 3. The verb 'IR' can be used with the infinitive verb to talk about what one is going to.

Example: Yo voy a estudiar. (I am going to study.)

Ellos van a jugar al fútbol. (They are going to play soccer.)
