

AP Chinese Summer Assignment

Due: Sep 6, 2024 before class

100 points x 2 (homework grade)

Your summer assignment consists of **three tasks: one interpretive task, one interpersonal task and one presentational task**. You will either type your assignment directly on your ePortfolio (Google Site) or provide a screenshot and upload the images to the page under Interpretive, Interpersonal, and Presentational respectively. Keep each entry on the top of the Google Site page.

- ***Do Not submit your Google Site file until new school begins. Your teacher will direct you to a new Google Classroom where you can turn in your work.***
- ***If you become a viewer of your own Google Site ePortfolio (you are not the owner), please reach out to your Chinese teacher immediately.***
- ***No late work will be accepted.***

Part A Interpretive Task is to:

- (1) Watch a video about Buxiban 補習班 (补习班) <https://youtu.be/2wrJVEla9es>
- (2) Review the following advertisement.
- (3) Answer the following questions:
 1. Where is the Buxiban in that video located?
 2. Why do students go to Buxiban?
 3. What does the teacher John teach? Answer the subjects he teaches in Chinese and English.
 4. According to Hailey and Adam in the video, what is their college application preparation different from the students they interviewed in the video? Answer in English.
 5. What is the advertisement promoting?
 6. On the advertisement, the place is called 成龍補習班 (成龙补习班), what does 成龍, 成鳳 (成龙, 成凤) mean in Chinese?

You can work this part directly on Google Site under the Interpretive page. You need to copy the questions, attach the image of this advertisement, and include the video link.

Part B Interpersonal task is to write (you initiate) 1 email and reply (after you receive the email) 1 email.

(1) Send an email in Chinese of any topic to Ms. Huang ellen.psu@gmail.com
Minimum 30 characters. Simply say hi is fine.

or

(2) Send an email to any friend/classmate in Chinese. Minimum 30 characters
and

(3) Reply the email to Ms. Huang in Chinese. Minimum 150 characters.

or

(4) Reply the email to the friend/classmate in Chinese. Minimum 150 characters.

Take screenshots of your email correspondence and upload the images to your ePortfolio under the Interpersonal page.

Part C Presentational task is to write a short story/essay about your summer vacation. Minimum 150 characters. You can talk about the places you visit, the job you take, or the fun activities you do with family/friends. You can work this part directly on Google Site under Presentational task. Attach any pictures, flyers, or documents as artifacts.

Manage your time well and break the tasks into several days or weeks to complete. Don't wait until the last minute to complete the assignment. All work needs to be done in Chinese.
