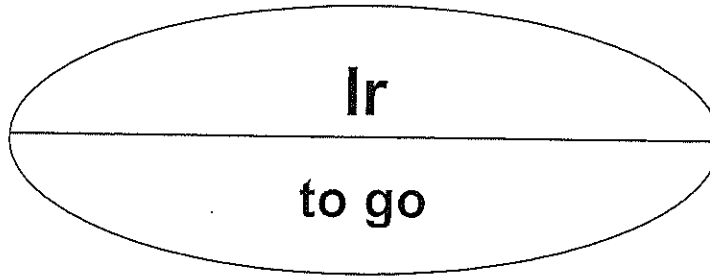


Tema El verbo 'Ir'



**Pregunta:** How do you conjugate the verb 'Ir'?

The following are the forms of the verb 'Ir':

<b>Yo <u>voy</u></b> (I go)	<b>Nosotros <u>vamos</u></b> (We go)
<b>Tú <u>vas</u></b> (You go)	
<b>Él</b> (He goes) <b>Ella <u>va</u></b> (She goes) <b>Usted</b> (You go) <small>Polite form</small>	<b>Ellos</b> (They go) <b>Ellas <u>van</u></b> (They go) <b>Ustedes</b> (You all go)

**RULES WHEN USING THE VERB 'IR'**

The verb ir is used when talking about where people go or are going.

Examples:

I go to the beach. } **Yo voy a la playa.**  
I am going to the beach.

1. The verb 'Ir' is always followed by the preposition 'a' (to).

Ir a = to go to Example: Yo voy a la escuela.  
(I go to school)

2. Don't forget that a + el = al Example: Ella va al supermercado.  
(She goes to the supermarket)

3. The verb 'IR' can be used with the infinitive verb to talk about what one is going to.

Example: Yo voy a estudiar. (I am going to study.)

Ellos van a jugar al fútbol. (They are going to play soccer.)
